Reading

Reading remains the most important learning activity that you can do with your child at home. I have noticed a huge difference in the progress made by those who read regularly. It is the key that will unlock the rest of their learning. Ideally they should read 4-5 times a week. The children will bring home new reading books on a Friday.
