Reading

<u>Optional Activities</u>: These are some ideas for some extra activities you could do and exchange for dojo points.

In English, we will be writing a narrative poem and an information text. As the 80th anniversary of VE Day occurs on May 8th, we will be writing about that. We will have limited time to discuss the

significance of VE Day and the impact of World War Two, so any reading about, watching of news reports, joining in street parties, etc, will be most valuable.

Our Geography unit this term is 'Climate across the World'. This will involve studying various climatic zones as well as the impact of climate change. The children could look at the climate in different parts of the world (especially anywhere they have travelled to; or have other links to) and compare it to the UK. They could investigate the impact of climate change on wildlife and what can be done to help.

Science- This term we are investigating forces. There are plenty of investigations the children could do around friction, acceleration, air resistance and pulleys.

Art- we will use secondary observational skills to draw and paint birds; this will be followed by creating 3D paper sculptures of birds. At home, the children could draw, paint and model birds using a range of different materials.

How can I support my child at home?

Encourage your child to complete all the homework tasks above. Remind your child to speak to an adult in school if they find things too easy or tricky. Have a look at the optional activities together and try to complete one of the tasks or find out more about that topic area (any extra learning is great!). If your child is finding things difficult, remind them to have a try and persevere. We would rather that the tasks were attempted, then not completed at all.
